Cyhoeddir yn y llyfr hwn gynnwys llawysgrif sydd ym meddiant Mr. Daniel Richard Watkins, Tynwydd, Pentyrch.

Trwy ei garedigrwydd ef yr argraffwyd ef gan Evan Phillips, Yscallog, Llandaf, i'w ddsbarthu yn gyfrinachol.

Yr oedd tadcu Mr. D. R. Watkins, sef Thomas Watkins, yn un o arolygwyr y plwyf yn 1833-4.

Sylwa'r cyfarwydd â ffiniau'r plwyf y dylid darllen "Llanilterne" lle yr ysgrifennwyd "Llanilltid." Cywirwyd y camsyniad mewn un man yn y llawysgrif (t. 26).

Gadawyd enwau'r ffermdai a'r caeau fel yr ysgrifennwyd hwynt.

Diolcha'r cyhoeddwr i Mr. G. J. Williams, M.A., am ei garedigrwydd yn edrych dros y profenni ac am ysgrifennu'r rhagair.

RHAGAIR.

Yn y gyfrol hon cyhoeddir cynnwys llawysgrif sy'n rhoi cyfrif manwl o diroedd plwyf Pentyrch yn y flwyddyn 1824. Diau mai'r rhai a gymer fwyaf o ddi-ddordeb ynddi fydd brodorion yr hen blwyf—plwyf y gwyddai holl Forgannwg gynt am lewder ei drigolion. "Bit rhyddoch chi, wŷr Pentyrch," meddai pobl yr ardaloedd cylchynol, pan godai helynt mewn ffair neu farchnad neu wylmabsant. Bydd yr enwau a geir yn y gyfrol, enwau ffermydd a thyddynnod a chaeau, yn dwyn ar gof iddynt hen hanesion a thraddodiadau ac arferion, a'r dyddiau llawen gynt pan ddeuai'r Fari Lwyd yn ei thro drwy'r pentrefi a heibio i'r tai ffermydd, a phawb, yn wŷr a gwragedd a phlant, yn Gymry o ran iaith, ac yn gwybod yr hen benillion traddodiadol a'r hen gofion a gawsai eu trosglwyddo o'r naill genhedlaeth i'r llall. Efallai fod rhai o'r hen drigolion wedi clywed eu teidiau'n sôn am y Twm Tincer a'r Wil y Gof, a'r Moses Lewis a'r Ieuan Bin y mae eu henwau'n aros o hyd ar gaeau'r plwyf. Gŵyr cylch ehangach am *Lwyn Daddu* (neu *Lwyn Dafydd Ddu*) oherwydd ei gysylltu â Dafydd Ddu ddewin, gŵr y dywedir iddo gyflawni campau rhyfeddol. Yn wir, ceisiodd rhai o haneswyr Morgannwg honni mai efô ydoedd Dafydd Ddu Hiraddug, gŵr enwog yn hanes llenyddiaeth Cymru yn yr Oesoedd Canol, ond ofnaf nad oes sail o fath yn y byd i hyn.

Ac o sôn am hanes y plwyf, carwn wneuthur un awgrym. Bu Pentyrch erioed yn enwog am ei Gymreigrwydd, am ei sêl dros bopeth Cymreig. Pan oedd yr ardaloedd cylchynol yn cael eu boddi gan fôr o Seisnigrwydd, parhaodd yr iaith yma yn hoyw ac yn dirf. A hyd yn oed heddiw, fe fynnir cadw cofnodion y Cyngor Plwyf yn Gymraeg. Ond erbyn hyn, iaith y canol oed a'r hen yn unig ydyw, ac yn nhrefl y blynyddoedd ni eill na ddiflana'r hen draddodiadau a'r hen fywyd diwylliadol. Ac ni eill dim fod yn fwy torcalonnus na gweled bro wedi colli ei thraddodiadau

a phob cof am y pethau a fu. Nid oes ond un ffordd i atal hyn, sef ennyn diddordeb y plant ym mywyd ac yn hanes eu hardal, a dysgu'r Gymraeg iddynt fel rhywbeth sy'n hanfodol gysylltiedig â'r bywyd hwnnw. Gŵyr pob athro profiadol mai peth cwbl ofer a di-fudd ydyw dysgu'r iaith yn yr ysgol fel pe byddid yn dysgu iaith estron neu bwnc tebyg i rifyddeg, heb ei chysylltu â bywyd bob dydd y plant. Ond o wneuthur hynny, buan y daw'r plant i garu'r Gymraeg ac i ymddiddori ynddi fel rhywbeth sy'n rhan o fywyd eu hardal hwy. Dangoswyd hyn eisoes mewn arbrawf hynod a wnaethpwyd mewn ardal ym Mro Morgannwg a oedd wedi ei llwyr Seisnigeiddio. Hyderaf y dyry'r gyfrol hon ryw gymaint o help i athrawon y cych i gyflawni'r gwaith hwn. Gwn na roddai dim fwy o lawenydd i'r gŵr a'i cyhoeddodd.

Ond bydd y gyfrol yn ddiddorol i lawer heblaw trigolion plwyf Pentyrch. Pwnc a gaiff gryn sylw gan ysgolheigion Cymru yn awr ydyw enwau lleoedd—enwau plwyfydd, pentrefydd, ffermydd, caeau, mynyddoedd, afonydd, etc. Ni eill yr ysgolhaig ymgymryd â'r gwaith o egluro'r enwau hyn nes darganfod eu ffurf yn y dogfennau cynharaf, a bydd pob llawysgrif a gynnwys enwau lleoedd o ddiddordeb arbennig iddo. Wrth gwrs, nid yw'r llawysgrif a gyhoeddir yma yn "hen" ddogfen, ond y mae'n bwysig oherwydd ei bod yn cynnwys enwau caeau'r plwyf. Y mae'r rhain yn aml yn newid o gyfnod i gyfnod, a bydd yr ysgolhaig yn falch o gael yma eu ffurf yn y flwyddyn 1824. Gallaf nodi rhai pwyntiau diddorol a ganfyddir wrth fyned trwy'r rhestri. Sylwer mai'r ffurf dafodieithol a ddigwydd yn aml iawn; er enghraifft, *pumer* a *dwyer* (t. 26 am *pumerw* a *dwyerw*; *corad* (tt. 1, 33) am *cored*; *onan* (t. 24) am *onnen*; *Ynys Goy* (t. 22) wrth ochr y ffurf lenyddol *Ynysgau* (t. 49). Weithiau, er hynny, fe lithrodd yr ysgrifennydd wrth geisio rhoi ffurf "barchus" gair, a cheir enghraifft dda o hynny ar d. 39, sef *Caer Gŵlrawdŷ*, oherwydd y mae'n sicr mai *glowty*, gair cwbl gyffredin yn y dafodiaith, sydd yma. Enghraifft o rywbeth tebyg ydyw *Caer highgras* (t. 3), *Caer Highgras* (t. 34), a *Dwyer Highgras* (t. 32). Dywed Mr. Tom John, Y Barri, gŵr y bu ei deidiau yn byw am genedlaethau yng Nghastell-y-mynach, mai *rye-grass* ydyw'r gair ac nid *highgrass*, a bod gwŷr Morgannwg wedi defnyddio'r enw Saesneg pan ddechreuwyd tyfu rhygwellt yng Nghymru tua diwedd yr ail ganrif ar bymtheg. Dyma'r math o "welliannau" a fu'n anurddo mapiau'r *Ordnance Survey* o Gymru. Sylwer hefyd ar *trane* (tt. 26 a 33).

Ymddengys i mi nad yw hon namyn lluosog *traen*, ffurf ar *traean* ("one-third"), fel y ceir *clae* wrth ochr *clae*r, a *harn* wrth ochr *haearn*. Dyma rai pwyntiau y sylwais arnynt, ond digon hyn i ddangos bod y rhestr o ddiddordeb i bawb sy'n astudio enwau lleoedd yng Nghymru.

Ac wrth orffen, dymunwn ddywedyd, fel un o drigolion y plwyf—er mai "dyn dwad" ydwyf ac nid "brodor"—y dylem ddiolch i'r ddau ŵr sy'n gyfrifol am yr argraffiad hwn; yn gyntaf, i Mr. D. R. Watkins am gadw a diogelu'r llawysgrif, ac yn ail, i Mr. Evan Phillips, y golygydd a'r cyhoeddwr. Dyma un arall o aml gymwynasau Mr. Phillips i'w hen blwyf.

And Whereas the s^d Inhabitants in Vestry assembled at the Navigators Arms Public House in the said Parish on the 20th day of Jan. last did further resolve & by an Agreement entered into & sign^d by the s^d Parishioners unanimously agree to Refer the matters in dispute respecting the Valuation of the Parish & the rate appealed agst (excepting the Works afors^d) to the award & determination of the s^d Evan David and M^r John Jenkins & that their Valuation sh^d be permanently agreed to by the s^d Parishioners.
